

• Mask distribution for contract labor, canteen staff, liftmen, civil labor, mathadi workers, vendors, small scale office staff, hospital staff, security guards, etc. was organized on 1st June 2020 at various locations on Sion-Trombay Road, Chembur. These areas were declared as Red Zone and so all precautionary measures like social distancing, etc. was followed with help of Shri. • Grocery and Mask distribution to cancer patients, their families and municipal school teachers was done on 9th June 2020 along with CST (NGO) and with help of RCF Management. During the lockdown, it was necessary for the cancer patients and their families to take care of themselves. They were more prone to infections than anyone else. Thus, to take care of them, mask distribution was arranged for them with awareness of hygiene and social distancing. At the same time Municipal school teachers were also most affected without any earning. So, Groceries were also distributed to the families of cancer patients and the teachers. Shri. Umesh Dongre (Director Finance, RCF) was the chief guest along with Shri. Dipak Deshpande (General Manager-Marketing, RCF), Shri. Dhananjay Khamkar (Senior Manager-Corp. Comm, RCF) as special guest. Shri. Henry Samuel, Jt. Secretary and other life members of QCFI helped in organizing the drive along with Chandra Sundra Trust (NGO).











• Grocery, Mask & Sanitizer distribution to Sangopita (Shelter for differently abled children).

Our QCFI GC and life members dared to visit Badlapur area on 28th June 2020 in an attempt to provide a helping hand to the NGO, Sangopita at Bendshil, Kharwai-Kondeshwar Rd., Badlapur (E), Thane, Maharashtra, which works for the upliftment of differently abled children, even though COVID19 cases are on an increased rate in the area. Lockdown has made them more dependent due to isolation, increased their needs and reduced the incoming help. Thus, the shelter was visited for timely help and providing them with needed groceries, masks and sanitizers. But both the trustees and managers were kind enough to attend our organizers at their daycare center in the city at Badlapur. The daycare center is equipped with sewing, weaving machines and also working tables, where they teach children to prepare paper bags cloth bags and even masks at such times of need. This helps the differently abled children to learn new things, practice and prepare needed items to sell and be self-sufficient i.e. 'ATMANIRBAR' as our Prime Minister appeals our Nation to be. All the donated groceries were deposited at the daycare center store in Badlapur city, where it will remain for two days under quarantine before been safely shifted to the shelter at Sangopita. They are taking all precautions to protect the children during the pandemic. We did our bit in extending our helping hand with everyone's support and good wishes. This act of kindness motivated others too to extend their helping hand towards the noble cause.
